
Fall Schedule 2012





Family Dog Training This 6 week class is for dogs of any age. We teach everyday manners, address management issues and provide help for annoying behavior problems. Current vaccination records are required. Be sure to ask questions if you have concerns about your dog's behavior. Dog's with aggression issues toward humans or dogs require pre-screening.

Steamboat Springs - Class time 10 to 11:30 a.m. starting Saturday Sept. 15, first class is orientation; no dogs – we will send you home with a training plan to prepare your dog for class. September 22 - 29 - Oct. 6 (break on Oct. 13) resume class Oct. 20 - 27

Craig - Class time 6 to 7:30 p.m. starting Wednesday Sept. 12 (Remember first class; no dogs) September 19 – 26 October 3 – (break Oct. 10) - 17 – 24. We will add additional classes for Head Start Puppy/Puppy STAR and C.L.A.S.S. in Craig as needed

Meeker - Class time 6 to 7:30 p.m. starting Monday Sept. 17, (Remember first class; no dogs) Sept. 24 October 1 – break Oct. 8th resume classes Oct.15 – 22 – 29.

Head Start Puppy Training – Steamboat Springs This class is for healthy puppies under five months old. Puppies are required to have a veterinarian check up and a clean bill of health. Vaccination records are required. Starts September 15th - 1pm to 2:30 pm. Sept. 22 – 29 – Oct. 6 – (break on Oct. 13). Resume Oct. 20 - 27



New - C.L.A.S.S.

Canine Life and Social Skills – Steamboat Springs - This class developed by APDT provides another great activity to strengthen communication and training using positive reinforcement and fun. We will assess your dog/handler core training skills and provide guidance for improving your teamwork training. Your proficiency in teaching and managing your dog will reach beyond basic "obedience" training.

This is an advanced class for family dog class or Canine Good Citizen graduates. If you would like to enroll you'll need to visit the C.L.A.S.S. web site and sign up with your dog. The first step in beginning the C.L.A.S.S. program is studying the rules and requirements in the Student Handbook. Go to: www.mydoghasclass.com and download the Student Handbook then register your dog.

Steamboat Springs September 15th 4 pm to 5 pm. You'll practice on your own and use class time for testing and help where needed. This class will run for 6 weeks. You will have the opportunity to progress through multiple levels as your skills improve.

Level 1 – B.A. skills include wait at the door, come and leashing up manners, loose leash walking and attention, meet and greet, leave it, wait for the food bowl, stay and settle.

Level 2 – M.A. skills include wait in the car, pass by other dogs, down/stand, handling, loose leash walking and leave it and stay.

Level 3 – Ph.D. skills include loose leash walking, back up, stay, come and leashing up manners, meet and greet, attention, table manners and sit.
